



Field Technician/Laborer

JOB DESCRIPTION

Summary/Objective

The Environmental/Industrial Services Technician performs a range of tasks required for industrial service operations to include but not limited to, tank cleaning, pipeline maintenance, manual remediation services, waste bulking, and/or demolition services, in accordance with established company policies and procedures and will also be responsible for assisting the on-site operator.

Ideal candidates will have a minimum of 2 years of environmental project experience, excellent references, and the demonstrated ability to perform the following:

Essential Functions

1. Perform physical labor associated with cleanup activities, sample collection, waste removal and other remediation services
2. Follow applicable safety rules, regulations, guidelines, policies, and site-specific safety plans when performing cleanup activities and donning protective gear
3. Operate routinely used tools and equipment
4. Perform routine inspection and preventive maintenance on assigned equipment
5. Warehouse maintenance, stock supplies, building maintenance
6. Ability to think on their feet, quickly adapt to the tasks at hand and even predict the next action

Competencies

2. Must demonstrate general knowledge of operations and ability to safely operate assigned equipment

Supervisory Responsibility

This position has no supervisory responsibilities.

Work Environment

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is frequently exposed to fumes or airborne particles, moving mechanical parts and vibration. Must be able to endure outdoor elements for most of the day every day.

Physical Demands

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to talk and hear. This position is very active and requires standing, walking, bending, kneeling, stooping, crouching, crawling and climbing all day. The employee must frequently lift and move items over 50 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception and ability to adjust focus.
